

Governor Lamont joined New York Governor Andrew Cuomo and Governors of nearby states in the region, New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Delaware, announcing that each Governor would name a public health official and an economic official to a group that will develop their back-to-work plan. Massachusetts Governor Baker has joined their multi-state council as well.

Governor Lamont today announced that former PepsiCo. CEO Indra Nooyi, a Greenwich resident and one of the governor's chief economic advisers, would co-chair an advisory board focused on re-opening the state, along with Yale School of Public Health epidemiologist, Dr. Albert Ko.
